- New Gamboge
- Cerulean Blue

- Burnt Umber
- Quinacridone Gold

Brushes

- 1 and 2 inch Flat
- 8 12 and 18 Round.

Paper

Arches Watercolor paper 140 lb. - seems to be the best all around watercolor paper. If you prefer other brands, bring them.

- kneaded eraser
- photographs for reference
- spray bottle or mister
- paper towels Viva is the nicest to work with
- palette for watercolors
- board large enough to support paper
